# New Fire Officer I & II Class Information

The latest information from the Michigan Fire Fighter Training Council and Office of Firefighter Training is the following prerequisite classes must be taken before the actual Fire Officer I & II class can be taken:

1. Incident Safety Officer (ISO)
2. Educational Methodology (Ed Meth)
3. Managing Company Tactical Operations – Preparing (MCTO-P)
4. Managing Company Tactical Operations – Decision Making (MCTO-D)  
3 & 4 must be taken together.
5. Strategies and Tactics for the Initial Company Officer – (STICO)
6. NIMS – Incident Command System for the Fire Service (must be the MFFTC course. Other NIMS/ICS courses do not count.)
7. Three years in the fire service.

Once the above prerequisites have been met you can take the actual Fire Officer I & II course. At this time the MFFTC is planning on offering the train the trainer class in late January or early February. When I have instructors to teach and enough people to fill a class I will schedule the Fire Officer I & II course. Initial information is that the Fire Officer I & II course will be 60 to 80 hours in length.
